Area: Brisbane pilotage area

Locality: Mooloolah River inner harbour

Activity: Dredging Operations

Mariners are advised that the cutter suction dredge 'Navua' and support work boats, will be undertaking dredging operations in the Mooloolah River inner harbour for approximately 6 weeks from 07 February 2020 until late March 2020, subject to change. Works throughout the period can be expected to oocur in daylight hours.

A semi-submerged pipeline will extend from the dredge and along the western side of the channel to the beginning of the western breakwater and will be marked by yellow buoys with lights. Mariners are to be aware that submerged cables will extend across the channel whilst the drede is in operation. The dredge will exhibit day shapes and lights as required by the Collision Regulations, and the dredge master will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16.

At night time the dredge will be secured to the pile moorings within the harbour. The floating pipeline will be secured and marked with flashing lights.

Mariners should navigate with caution in the area and also remain mindful of their wash and the operational speed limit of 6 knots in the vicinity of anchored vessels.
