Should Start times be earlier for points score and later for non-aggregate?  
Should Start times be different for different tide times?
  - 2.4. More SAMS & WAMS or more "specials" such as BWS/LOPS, IBC, Overnight, etc?
  - 2.5. Lady Helm Series – poorly attended – do we want it or not?
  - 2.6. Mostly points score or more non-aggregate ("Fun") races?
  - 2.7. A single points score series for whole season or several short series of 3 – 4 months?
3. What do boat owners want as **COURSES:**
  - 3.1. Short, medium, long? Windward/leeward?
  - 3.2. Suggestions for new courses please.
4. Any **volunteers** to assist in running the races?  
Should a "duty boat" concept be introduced to rotate the task of running the club races?  
(TopYacht can allocate "average points" to each duty boat for their duty week.)
